Theme:	Maximize the accuracy of loan loss prediction model

The teams analyzed and developed their models using data held by AIFUL Group and competed for the high accuracy of the prediction model. Students at the University of Tokyo won the grand prize. Students who participated in the competition commented that it was a valuable experience and that they would like to learn more and participate in other hackathons again.
